ClubLink Appeals Glen Abbey Golf Club Redevelopment Applications to OMB

TORONTO (OCT. 10, 2017) – Earlier today, ClubLink filed appeals to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) of its redevelopment applications for the Glen Abbey Golf Club.

The appeals of ClubLink’s Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendment applications follow a decision by Town Council to refuse these applications at its meeting on September 27, 2017. ClubLink has now also exercised its right to appeal its subdivision application to the OMB based on the Town’s failure to make a decision on that application within the prescribed time period set out in the *Planning Act*.

The Town Clerk will now be obligated to forward each of the appeals to the OMB, and the OMB will then hold a hearing to consider the merits of ClubLink’s applications to redevelop the golf course for a mix of residential, commercial and open space uses.

The applications include the conveyance to a public authority of the entirety of the Sixteen Mile Creek valley lands, as well as a significant amount of the property’s tablelands, totaling approximately 54% of the entire property, or 124 acres, as permanent publicly-accessible greenspace.
